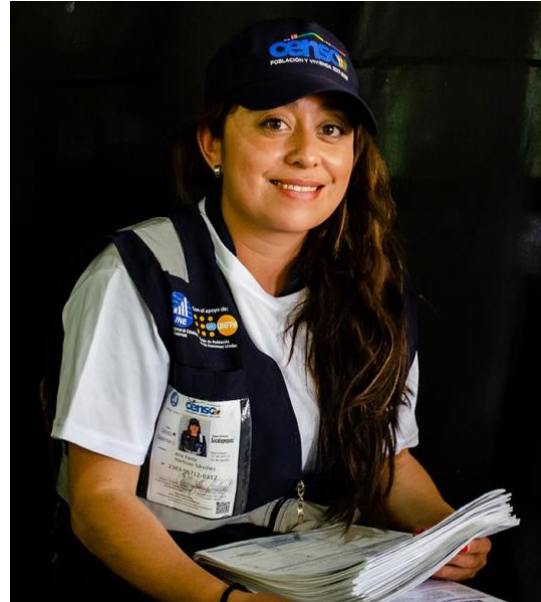


Counting the world: One census at a time
